- Explore emerging research and policy trends to expand, strengthen, and diversify the academic, clinical, and leadership preparation of nurses for optimized national health.

Please submit the form below by **Thursday, October 16, 2025, at 11:59 PM EST**. Accepted applications will be notified in early December. Historically, two standing workshops include: 1) a Funding Agencies Update and 2) an Editors' Presentation. We will prioritize workshops that highlight nursing knowledge addressing the impact of social determinants of health on the individual, community and/or populations. Examples of potential workshop topics include how to: design, implement, and disseminate nursing science that promotes health equity and addresses disparities; implement creative PhD-DNP research collaborations to address the needs of a diverse society; utilize findings from nursing science to influence policy or implement change in practice. All presenters are required to be paid registrants for the ENRS Conference.
