### **Description of the 37th Annual Scientific Sessions:**

The Eastern Nursing Research Society (ENRS) is pleased to accept abstracts to be considered for presentation at the ENRS 37th Annual Scientific Sessions entitled, *Collaborative partnerships in nursing research for the health and well-being of individuals, families, communities and populations*.

This year's theme is: **Freedom to advance health and well-being through revolutionary nursing research partnerships**

The 37th Annual Scientific Sessions appeal to all individuals interested in advancing nursing science, including nurse researchers, leaders in evidence-based practice, and dedicated nursing science students and faculty.

### **Conference Objectives:**

- Describe interprofessional and collaborative programs of nursing research that address health inequities and reduce disease burden across the lifespan.
- Identify effective team-based nursing research approaches that leverage the innovative use of technologies to advance health and well-being.
- Examine strategic research training and educational partnerships for nurses to address health and wellness across clinical, community, educational, and policy settings.

ENRS Workshops are one hour in length. Interested parties should complete the Concurrent Workshop Proposal Form below.

Please submit the form below by **Wednesday, November 6, 2024, at 11:59 PM EST**. Accepted applications will be notified in early December. Historically, two standing workshops include: 1) a Funding Agencies Update and 2) an Editors' Presentation. We will prioritize workshops that highlight nursing knowledge addressing the impact of social determinants of health on the individual, community and/or populations. Examples of potential workshop topics include how to: design, implement, and disseminate nursing science that promotes health equity and addresses disparities; implement creative PhD-DNP research collaborations to address the needs of a diverse society; utilize findings from nursing science to influence policy or implement change in practice. All presenters are required to be paid registrants for the ENRS Conference.
